Executive Summary

Highlights of our yearly Swedish Industry in Brazil Survey 2008 are:

- 1. <u>The Swedish "machine" in Brazil is growing</u> The total annual turnover for 2007 is more than BRL 27 billion and shows an impressive 17.6% Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) since 2004
- 2. <u>Companies believe in Brazil</u> Confidence is at a 4-year high, with planned investments at BRL 1.8 billion, up BRL 0.3 billion from 2006
- 3. <u>Trade is on the increase</u> Total imports and exports by Swedish companies in Brazil increased by 36% and 16%, respectively, compared to 2006
- 4. <u>Workforce stronger than ever</u> Swedish Industry in Brazil has 50.000 employees up 2.000 employees from 2006.

Swedish industry in Brazil overview

- Since Lars Magnus Ericsson sold the first phone to Brazil's King Dom Pedro II in 1891, over 200 Swedish companies have been established in Brazil.
- Large Swedish investments in Brazil started in the 1950s with a concentration in the São Paulo region, the financial heart of Latin America.
- Today, just about all large Swedish corporations are present in Brazil with their own production.
- New companies starting up are in the majority small and medium-sized companies with high technology.



The annual turnover in 2007 reached more than BRL 27 billion. An increase of more than 60% in 3 years




The investments in 2007 were lower than in 2006...

...although the confidence has increased significantly – 82 % in three years



In 2007, total imports and exports by Swedish companies in Brazil increased by 36% and 16%, respectively, compared to 2006




Imports and exports of Swedish companies in Brazil BRL million



Trade between Sweden and Brazil is also increasing and exports grew by 24% and 54% respectively between 2006 and 2007







Investments in cultural and social projects have skyrocketed over the past years, now at BRL 27 million. Tax incentives from the Brazilian tax authorities are successful


